Subject: Energy Crisis Service Call

Basis: Guideline Update

Purpose: The change to the Energy Crisis section is to establish the distinction of the Energy Crisis Service Call Program as a separate operation run under the WAP. The intent of clarifying this separation is to help in the management of the approved activities and allowable costs.

Scope: This change applies to all current and future applicants. This change will apply to all work that is not in progress on the Effective Date.

Exception: Agencies that have a current warehouse inventory of atmospheric water heaters may continue to replace a water heater under a Energy Crisis Service Call for target clients until that inventory is exhausted. Invoices dated after the Effective Date will be disallowed.

Responsibilities:

Local Agencies –

- Implement new policy and conduct in house training to inform staff.
- Deplete current inventory of atmospheric water heaters.

State WAP Staff –

- Amend Program Guidelines and publish.
